In pursuance to the same, Shri Anshul Garg, Chief Executive Officer, Shri Mata Vaishno Devi Shrine Board, inaugurated the program at village Natali, in the presence of officers / officials from the

meticulously reared in the Board's high-tech nursery at village Kunia in Panthal area (near Katra). CEO added that recent initiatives of Board are not only in alignment with environment stewardship but also is a testament to Board's dedication to preserving the nature and fostering ecological balance of the region.

CEO, SMVDSB exhorted that dronebased afforestation initiative is expected to have far reaching benefits adding over that



next 10 years, the Forest Wing of Board intends to cover 100 hectare of degraded patches every year. He underscored ecofriendly endeavors being part of Board's broader efforts to conserve the environment and ecology by carrying out the greening of Trikuta Hills and the spaces along the tracks leading to the Shrine. He also drew attention to numerous initiatives undertaken for the waste management, water management, and solar power generation and aligning these to Prime Minister's 'Ek Ped Maa Ke Naam' campaign.

On 7th August, the Board launched a comprehensive campaign for the cleanliness of Banganga rivulet, aligning it with the Swachh Bharat Mission and Swachhta Pakhwada initiative. The drive was launched as per the directions of Chairman SMVDSB, Shri Manoj Sinha, Hon'ble Lt. Governor, JK-UT and was led by Shri Anshul Garg, CEO, SMVDSB.The campaign aimed to maintain the sanctity and cleanliness of the holy rivulet, ensuring it remains pollution-free. The initiatives included removing litter, debris and silt from the rivulet with participants taking the Swachhta Pledge.

On the occasion, CEO emphasized the importance of maintaining cleanliness and sanitation in the holy town, urging cooperation of locals and pilgrims. The CEO also stated that to enhance the spiritual and aesthetic experience of devotees, the Board also plan to launch a Banganga Arti and Multimedia Laser Show.

Notably, the Shrine Board has taken various initiatives for ensuring sanitation and cleanliness along the tracks and conservation of environment and ecology of Trikuta Hills. These measures include setting up a mule dung based biogas plant at Banganga, Sewage Treatment Plants at various locations on the track (for waste water treatment and recycling treated water for greening initiatives) the construction of water harvesting ponds, afforestation drives in Trikuta Hills and rooftop rainwater harvesting etc. Additional initiatives include planting over 1.50 lakh seedlings annually to prevent soil erosion and a dronebased afforestation drive to increase green cover.

CEO SMVDSB Inaugurates Telemedicine Studio at SMVD Narayana Superspeciality Hospital

In a significant step aimed at enhancing healthcare services for devotees and the local community, Shri Anshul Garg, CEO, SMVDSB inaugurated a state-of-the-art Telemedicine Studio at the SMVD Narayana Superspeciality Hospital on September 9.

This initiative allows real-time consultations between doctors on the Vaishno Devi track and medical experts at the Hospital, providing instant access to specialized medical advice and improving response to the medical emergencies.

The Telemedicine Studio is a result of a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) signed between SMVDSB, Hewlett Packard Enterprise India Private Limited (HPEIPL) and Hewlett Packard (India) Software Operation Private Limited (HPISO) on April 6 this year, as per the directions of Shri Manoj Sinha, Lt Governor, JK-UT and Chairman, SMVDSB. The MoU aims to install nine cloud-enabled state-of-the-art Health ATMs along the revered Vaishno Devi pilgrimage track and one Telemedicine Studio at Katra.

With this initiative, the Board aims to integrate modern technology with traditional healthcare practices, thereby ensuring quality medical services for all. The goal is to provide a safe and convenient experience to millions of pilgrims visiting the shrine each year.

It is pertinent to mention here that the Board provides free accident insurance cover of Rs.5 lakh to each pilgrim visiting the Holy Shrine besides free treatment to devotees falling sick on the yatra track.

CEO SMVDSB calls for joint efforts to ensure smooth Navratra celebrations

Shri Anshul Garg, Chief Executive Officer, Shri Mata Vaishno Devi Shrine Board chaired a crucial review meeting on September 30 to ensure a seamless pilgrimage experience during the Shardiya Navratra period, October 3-12, 2024. The meeting held at Spiritual Growth Centre, Katra brought together security agencies and local authorities to assess critical areas like security and operational preparedness. included representatives from Attendees SMVDSB, SSP Reasi, CRPF, Army, IB, CID, intelligence Fire Services. and other agencies.

Key measures discussed replacing RFID cards with new RFID cards for enhanced security, mandatory registration for pilgrims, and setting up of 08 new registration counters at Katra's Railway Station. The CEO emphasized need for thorough frisking, verification, census of pony porters for mitigating security risks besides, robust crowd management, fire safety. smooth preparedness, vehicle disaster movement, improved sanitation, drinkina water supply and enhanced lighting in the Shrine area and Katra. Security agencies to deploy drones, were asked CCTV additional forces cameras, and quick response teams to ensure safety of pilgrims.

Security agencies presented a detailed action plan envisaging, inter-alia, use of CCTV cameras for real-time monitoring besides deployment of additional security forces and quick response teams (QTRs).

CEO Shrine Board vows for unwavering commitment to Pilgrim Facilities on Independence Day
